Thank you for your inquiry about Project MUSE. For pricing purposes I am classifying National Library of the Czech Republic as a Special library in a (Special) High Income country. Based on this your Project MUSE collection prices are as follows, in US Dollars:

These prices are for a calendar year subscription January 1-December 31.

We offer pro rata pricing for subscriptions that begin after the first of the year. To calculate the pro rata amount simply divide the annual fee by 12 and multiply by the number of months remaining in the subscription year.

A pro rata start for August 1 2013-December 31 2013 for the Standard Collection will be: \$2083.34

A pro rata start for August 1 2013-December 31 2013 for the Basic Research Collection will be: \$1708.34

Regarding annual price increases for 2014 and beyond. We expect that the Standard Collection will have a max annual price increase of about 4%.

We expect the Basic Research Collection will have a max annual price increase of about 3%. The actual price increase each year is based on the new titles added to each collection so I can't tell you for sure what the increases will be for 2014-15-16-17 but you can estimate based on the 4% and 3% increases.

Yes, remote access is available and allowed. We offer access via IP, proxy server, referring URL, and Shibboleth--although we have not yet implemented Shibboleth for the Czech Republic.

At this time our only subscriber in Czech Republic is University Hradec Kralove. They get the Social Science Collection. I'd be happy to work with you to see if we can establish a MUSE consortium in Czech Republic.

If there is a minimum of five institutions on a single invoice, single payment I will offer a discount off each institution's collection price of 10%.
